ARE YOU YET STANDING?

As we look at the story of the woman with the issue of blood in Luke 8:43-48, we can see that she had such a persistence and "no quit" attitude. She was determined to get what she was after, which was complete healing in her body.

I can imagine what she must have had to go through day and night with the issue she was facing. Discomfort, embarrassment, seclusion and isolation, the thought of, "when is this going to be over", etc. Can you identify with some of these emotions? I know I can.

This woman was so insistent on getting healed from the issue, that she kept spending her money on doctors and probably treatments to help her, but nothing was working for 12 years. Wow, that is a long time to go through and endure what she was facing, talk about, "yet standing". She shows us that if you really believe and have faith in something, in her case, that healing was hers to be had, we should stand for that thing, in faith, no matter what.

I am so learning that in this season I am in. Many things have come to try and take me from what I believe, stand for and have conviction about and I say, "yet standing in faith and truth", just like this woman. I am so encouraged by her story and I hope you can be as well. If you are finding yourself in a place where it seems hard and you are asking, "when will the other side come?" just know that if you continue to stand in faith on what you know, your other side, will come soon enough.

Just as we see in this story, her persistence and yet standing in faith attitude, got her to her desired end, being completely healed. She pressed in to the One that she perceived could REALLY help her, Jesus. Many things try to come and get our eyes off of our understanding, convictions, truth, promises, stance in faith, etc, but as we know, He makes the difference, so continue to press forward in faith, towards Him.

I encourage you to assess where you are and make sure you are "yet standing in faith", even if it seems hard, your other side, *Is Nigh You*, as you do, receive that!

Psalm 139:14



We all know how beautiful butterflies are and when we see them we just stare at their beauty. To think that they did not once look like they do, is a very interesting thought. They were once caterpillars that were squirming around and unable to fly.

Book of the Month




